

**Household of Princess Charlotte Augusta of Wales (1796-1817)
and Prince Leopold of Saxe-Coburg (c. 1818-1831) 1796-1831**

By 1803, £6,000 was set aside from the Civil List for the support of Princess Charlotte.¹ By 1830-31, Prince Leopold had been granted an annuity of £50,000 paid out of the Consolidated Fund.
